



IANA Introduces New Intermodal Tractor Registry (ITR)

We are pleased to introduce a new value added service for UIIA Motor Carriers, the **Intermodal Tractor Registry (ITR)**. The ITR is an expansion of the Intermodal Driver Database (IDD) and provides a method for Motor Carriers to manage both their drivers and the registration of tractors/trucks in a centralized database. The ITR was developed in an effort to assist Motor Carriers with meeting the Drayage Truck Regulation (title 13, California Code Regulation, Section 2027), which requires all registered owners or lessees of drayage trucks, which transport cargo to and from California ports and intermodal rail facilities, to register truck/tractor information in the California Air Resource Board (CARB) Equipment Registration (ARBER) system.

The Intermodal Tractor Registry (ITR) allows Licensed Motor Carriers (LMC) to register specific truck/tractor information on behalf of their company and owner operators. LMCs must first accept the terms and conditions of the IANA ITR Agreement after which they will have the ability to complete the CARB registration process. IANA will compile all registration information and upload to CARB on a daily basis. IANA will download the CARB compliance information each day from the ARBER website and this information will be maintained in IANA's ITR. Licensed Motor Carriers will also have the ability to access the ITR to determine if tractors/trucks registered under their SCAC Code are in compliance with the CARB regulation. This would include those trucks that were registered directly with CARB.

In addition, new reports for company tractors have been added, and existing reports available to Motor Carriers through the IDD have been enhanced to include the truck/tractor license plate, license state, CARB compliance status, Compliance Until Date and DTR Number, if one has been issued to the tractor by CARB.

Motor Carriers looking for an efficient method to manage their company trucks and/or trucks for the owner operators they utilize are encouraged to take advantage of the new Intermodal Tractor Registry (ITR). In addition, Motor Carriers that service ports and rail intermodal facilities in California and have not yet registered with CARB should consider taking advantage of the new online CARB registration process available in the ITR.

There is a one-time Excel file upload feature available to Motor Carriers that have a 100 or more trucks that they would like to register with CARB. Motor Carriers interested in using this one-time process should contact the UIIA office via e-mail at uiia@intermodal.org. Please note that any tractor information included in the files for companies currently providing auto IDD updates will not go through the CARB registration process. CARB registration for a mass volume of trucks can only be done through the one-time Excel file upload to CARB.
