RE: Effective Date of UIIA Revisions

A memo was sent to all UIIA participants on May 6, 2019 extending an additional thirty-day period for UIIA participants to review and submit comments on revisions to the proposed language in Section E.2.e. These revisions were made by the Intermodal Interchange Executive Committee at its April 30th meeting based on comments that had been submitted by UIIA participants during their initial review of this proposed modification. The new Section E.2.e. introduces a requirement for EPs to notify MCs of outstanding interchanged equipment on a monthly basis. The additional revision was to clarify that the intent of the EP's monthly notice was for informational purposes only and any errors or omissions in the content of the data would not relieve Parties from their interchange obligations under the UIIA.

The thirty-day period to submit comments on the proposed revisions to Section E.2.e. closed on June 5, 2019 with no comments being received from UIIA participants. During a conference call held on June 11, 2019, the Intermodal Interchange Executive Committee voted to approve the revised Section E.2.e. under the UIIA. **This revision will become effective on July 1, 2019.** For your convenience, the new provision is shown below:

Section E.2. Lost, Stolen or Destroyed Equipment, New Item E.2.e.

“Provider will notify the Motor Carrier electronically, at least once a month, of any outstanding Equipment that is shown on the Provider’s books as being interchanged under the Motor Carrier’s SCAC. Notice will be provided in a data file format and include equipment identification number and date of Interchange. Notice is provided for information only; errors or omissions in the content do not relieve the Parties of their respective Interchange obligations.”
