Insurance Collection for TRAC Intermodal

IANA is pleased to announce that it has partnered with TRAC Intermodal to develop a faster and more efficient insurance compliance process for TRAC's motor carrier customers. Starting October 7, 2019, IANA will collect and maintain all insurance documents for TRAC Connect motor carrier customers. This will eliminate the need for the motor carrier or their insurance agent to send separate certificates of insurance to TRAC.

Please note that TRAC will continue to manage their TRAC Connect Equipment Interchange Agreement so questions regarding this contract should be directed to TRAC directly at customerservice@tracintermodal.com or (877)987-2226, Option 2.

Current UIIA Motor Carrier Participating Also Doing Business with TRAC

UIIA Motor Carriers that also do business with TRAC Intermodal under their TRAC Connect program will need to have their insurance agent submit a new certificate of insurance online to the UIIA that adds TRAC as an additional insured. The additional insured must be listed under Interpool, Inc. d/b/a TRAC Intermodal, its affiliates, subsidiaries and Chassis Lessors and TRAC must be listed as additional insured on the motor carrier's auto, general and trailer interchange policies. In addition, please ensure that your current insurance limits on file with the UIIA meets TRAC's insurance requirements. **For your reference, [click here for TRAC's insurance requirements](#).**

Deleted UIIA Motor Carriers Doing Business with TRAC

If your company previously participated in the UIIA, you can still access your UIIA account online by going to <https://www.uiia.org/motor-carrier-login> on the Information Service website. You will log in with your SCAC Code and the password you established prior to being deleted from the UIIA. If you do not know your password, you can click on the FORGOT PASSWORD on the UIIA login page. Your password will be sent via e-mail to the last contact we had on file for your company prior to it being deleted from the UIIA.

Your insurance agent will need to submit a new certificate of insurance online to IANA's office. You will need to provide your agent with your Insurance Agent Code and SCAC Code in order to submit insurance for your company that meets TRAC's insurance requirements. **For your reference, [click here for TRAC's insurance requirements](#).** Your company will also need to make sure that your SCAC Code and MC & DOT Numbers are active.

Non-UIIA Motor Carriers Doing Business with TRAC

Motor Carriers that have never participated in the UIIA program, will need to register with IANA to establish an account so we can collect insurance for your company on behalf of TRAC. To registered as a Non-UIIA Motor Carrier company, please go to <https://www.uiia.org/non-uiia-mc-login> and follow the online instructions. You will also need to have your insurance agent submit a certificate of insurance to IANA that meets TRAC's requirements. If your agent is not registered with IANA to submit insurance online, the agent will also need to register with our office by clicking on the following link [INSURANCE AGENT REGISTRATION](#). Your agent will need your company's SCAC and Insurance Agent Code (provided upon Motor Carrier registration) the initial time they submit insurance for your company to our office.
